In response to the Scoping Report (July 2013) the Trust has the following comments at this stage:

Facts and Figures:

Heritage, Para 1.22: It is unclear why some *designated heritage assets* are picked out for special mention, but not all. For example, there is no mention of registered parks and gardens, which as a result may downplay their significance.

Amount and Distribution of Development:

The options regarding the distribution of development should be guided, and tested, by clear sustainability criteria.

Environment:

Para 2.55: In principle Option 2 that seeks a broader environmental strategy should be explored, whilst recognising the importance of local distinctiveness within it.
